2023 Freshman Application for College and Vocational School Scholarship Award

All Freshman Applications are Due Friday, March 17, 2023, by 6:00PM

*****PLEASE READ THE APPLICATION CAREFULLY*****

This application must be typed via google docs. We must have full access to the application when turned in. All sections must be completed before it will be accepted.

All applicants must have been an active member of the Boys & Girls Club of Greenwich for at least two years or have been employed by BGCG for at least two years and your membership must be current.

Annual membership cost is <u>\$25.00</u> per person.

Preference will be given to applicants based on the number of years they have been a member of the Boys & Girls Club as well as applicant's continued participation and commitment to the Club.

*Please be aware that applying for a Boys & Girls Club of Greenwich Scholarship does not guarantee that you will receive a financial award. All applications will be reviewed by the committee and recipients will be notified if/when their interview will take place.

Applicants may apply for a scholarship in their Senior year of high school as well as within their first three years of college/university. Applicants are eligible for four years of college support.

Applicants must show proof of enrollment/acceptance in an accredited institution: a two-year community college, a four-year college/university, or an accredited vocational school.

All scholarship recipients are required to complete a minimum of <u>20 hours</u> of volunteer service to the Club during their granted period and prior to reapplication for additional funds. These activities may include volunteering in the after-school program, athletic leagues, special events or summer camps. If hours are not completed in the 2023 granted year, the applicant will be deemed ineligible for funds in subsequent years.

Applicants must submit a completed application, two one-page essays, a copy of their financial aid award letter, a current high school transcript of all 4 years, a head shot phot (wallet size 2.5" x 3.5") and two letters of recommendation specifically addressing their qualifications for a 2023 scholarship award. One recommendation letter must be from a current teacher or advisor.

Grammar, spelling, effort, and content all are discussed among Committee Members in determining an applicant's award eligibility. The application, essays and recommendation letters must all be typed and spell-checked.

ON SEPARATE SHEETS OF PAPER, SUBMIT TWO ONE PAGE ESSAYS. <u>PLEASE NOTE THAT ESSAY #1 IS</u> <u>MANDATORY.</u> ESSAY #2 CAN BE IN RESPONSE TO EITHER TOPICS 2, 3 OR 4. PLEASE NOTE THAT SPELLING, GRAMMAR, AND CONTENT ALL IMPACT THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE'S DECISION MAKING.

Two one-page essays saved as a PDF, including last name, first name and year entering Fall of 2023.

Complete High School transcripts: 4 years of high school transcripts through spring semester for 2023 academic year saved as a PDF, including last name, first name. Final grades and financial aid award letters are the only paperwork that can be turned into the Boys & Girls Club after the application deadline.

Two letters of recommendation specifically addressing your eligibility for a 2023 BGCG Scholarship Award.

One recommendation letter must be from a current teacher or advisor.

A hi-resolution head shot photograph (wallet size 2.5" x 3.5").
