

# **BGCG Membership: WELCOME TO THE CLUB!**

For generations, Boys & Girls Club of Greenwich (BGCG) has been the primary provider of high-quality, low-cost youth programs for the entire community. Our annual membership fee of \$75 for children and \$25 for high school youth, covers participation in our After-School Program for a full academic year for youth ages 6 - 18. Membership is renewed at the beginning of each calendar year.

Strong relationships with caring adult professionals and fun, age-appropriate programming are among the goals behind BGCG's programs in: Academic Success; Aquatics; Arts & Technology; Character & Leadership Development; and Health & Fitness.

### **Daily Activities**

On a typical day, 320 children arrive at the Club, eat a healthy snack and from 3:00 - 6:00 p.m. rotate with his or her grade level to the:

- Gym, field house or outside turf field for supervised athletic games
- Learning center for homework help
- Arts & crafts room for hands-on projects
- Library or computer center for academic enrichment
- Pool for swim lessons
- Game room for recreation

Additional activities such as swim team, cooking, flag football, and character development workshops from 4:30 – 7:30 p.m. are included in the \$75 annual membership fee. These enrichment activities are grouped into fall, winter, and spring sessions and require pre-registration, which opens a few weeks before programming begins.

#### School Vacations & Summer Camp

BGCG is open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. during school vacations and most holidays offering members a number of activities. Throughout the summer, the Club runs three separate day camp programs: Clubhouse Camp and Camp Simmons for children ages 6-12, and Teen Camp for youth ages 13-15, all at a weekly cost of \$175.

#### **Special Activities**

Throughout the year, members participate in special celebrations such as Trunk or Treat, Thanksgiving Feast, holiday party, Pancake Breakfast, and teen nights.

## **After-School Snapshot**

2:45 - 3:15 p.m. Town of Greenwich buses pick members up from Cos Cob, Glenville, Hamilton Avenue, Julian Curtiss, New Lebanon, North Street, Parkway, Western Middle School, and Greenwich High School. BGCG buses pick members up from International School at Dundee, North Mianus, Old Greenwich\*, Riverside, Central Middle School, and Eastern Middle School.

**3:00 - 3:30 p.m.** Members arrive at BGCG and enjoy a healthy snack.

**3:30 - 6:00 p.m.** Members work on homework, and rotate with their grade level through various activities.

**4:30 p.m.** Enrichment activities begin.

**6:00 p.m.** Members are picked-up by a parent or guardian, anytime before 6:00 p.m. Parents enter the parking lot, drive to the main door where a staff member radios for the child to meet the parent in their car.

**4:30 - 7:30 p.m.** Members participate in scheduled enrichment activities, before being picked up by a parent or guardian.
